What?

ccs vs gs concepts and prolegomena

- **ccs** are "territory related" <-> **gs** and IDN **gs** are generic and unrelated
- There is a list of territories: ISO3166
- Latin **CCs** and IDN **CCs** are just different "forms of expression" generated from a same given territory

What?

- **ccs**, either ASCII or other scripts, are natural members of ccNSO
- a la RFC 1591: "The IANA is not in the business of deciding what is and what is not a country", the ccNSO is not in the business of deciding what is and what is not a territory. So we stick to the ISO-3166, the only secure way to preserve the concept of what is a CC.

What? Aimed to:

Include IDN **ccs** as an effective part of the ccNSO

- Keep the concept of a **cc** as solid as possible
- •Decouple the eventual necessity of many (tens? hundreds?) IDN **ccs** for a particular territory **from** the voting mechanism.

What? Results:

- Include IDN **ccs** as effective members of ccNSO
- •Keep the right balance of *One Territory, One Vote*, no matter how populated, how big or how many different "forms of expression" the specific territory have.
