Topic: Voting

- very important issue that will influence the basis of ccNSO
 - WG2 is under discussion, having no preference by now
 - your input is necessary and very important
- Solution space
 - one vote per territory (=listed in ISO 3166)
 - one vote per member
- situations necessary to be considered
 - one organization acts as registries of multiple ASCII cc's
 - one organization acts as registries of an ASCII plus IDN ccTLD(s) within Territory
 - IDN ccTLD(s) is(are) operated by different organization(s) from ASCII's
 - IDN ccTLD(s) in a territory does not correspond to the whole territory
